2yr old brindle dog really liked this dog a great deal he has so much to like, super head with excellent size, depth and width. Good eyes and muzzle and teeth. strong neck leading to a very nice body which again had good length and depth, good deep wide chest, on excellent strong well boned legs with correct angles on tight well shaped feet, would like a little more strength at the rear to improve drive on the move, a small fault that could not detract from my winner, was more than happy to award Best Dog and Best In Show one to watch in future shows

2nd Mr J. & Mrs C. Whelan's FRAGILIS FIREWORK

2yr old brindle dog, nice head, with good stop and muzzle and little loose in the eye. Good bones and feet, Would prefer slightly more body mass, but had a good level top line, moved very well

3rd Mrs D. Chapman's KUMORMAI CLOSE ENCOUNTER

2yr old fawn dog, pleasing head nice eye and ear placement, nice body with good chest, strong boned legs but slightly straight rear angles causing an un-level top line and unbalanced movement the difference between second and third.

Untypical head shape but kind expression slightly loose in the eye, correct ear placement, nicely up-to weight body on well boned legs with tight feet good rear leg angles, lost out to my first on movement today



1st Mrs D.K. Paver's CAMAHIEU SPIRITUAL MYSTERY

11month old brindle bitch, with kind expression, however a little long in the muzzle, eye was dark but round in shape. Would prefer much more bone and body mass both fore and aft, moved quite well when finally got going.

2yr old fawn bitch. Very pretty head, with good shape and planes, good stop and dark eye, strong neck and shoulders leading to well shaped body, well off for bone for her size on tight well formed feet, nice rear angles creating a level top line which was carried well on the move, very pleased with her and was happy to award BOS.

2nd Mrs K. Dodd-Utting, Mrs E. Herring & Mr J. Dodd's SUNCAMO MRS T BINDY BY HEFFALUMP

7yr old brindle bitch very nice head with a kind expression, good shoulder with strong well boned legs, slightly dippy top line which can be excused to some degree by her age good rear angles and correct tail set, still able to move well at 7yrs

7yr old brindle bitch, attractive head with good tight, dark eye, good deep wide chest, well off for bone with good rear angles. Needs to drop a little weight help with her movement.
